**Polarization and the Public Interest:
How Does It Impact Students & Schools?**

The New York Education Policy Leadership Program (NY EPLP) is a unique, yearlong professional development experience that focuses on policy, leadership, and networking. The program explores timely education policy and leadership issues at the macro, strategic level through immersive experiences and virtual, interactive sessions.

NY EPLP Fellows will gain a broad view of policy issues and implications, and better understand the dynamics of strategic, situational leadership by:

- Engaging in 7 monthly Friday Zoom sessions featuring seminar-style discussions with Fordham University professors and prominent speakers in education policy and leadership.
- Joining colleagues from MI, OH, and PA for an in-person **Strategic Leadership Forum in Pennsylvania** (October 6 & 7, 2022):
 - Docent-led strategic leadership experience on the Gettysburg Battlefield
 - U.S. Army War College faculty shares strategic leadership concepts taught to military leaders, yet relevant for all leaders.
- Convening in **Washington DC** for a full-day of **insightful meetings** with education think-tank experts and influencers of education policy representing a broad range of perspectives (March 10, 2023).
- Collaborating on a **team Policy Analysis Project** to research and develop a policy position on a topic of interest, and complete a group policy paper and oral presentation.

Education leaders with a strong track record and a passion for education policy and equity issues. The diverse, statewide cohort of up to 25 Fellows is open to: school district and building administrators; private, parochial, and charter school leaders; education organization leaders; school board members; and graduate students.

Program fee for the full-year hybrid program is \$1,975. PA and DC travel/hotel costs, estimated at \$950, are not included. (Program fee is an aidable BOCES staff development CO-SER; non-BOCES schools will incur an additional administrative fee).
